Chairman Harrington opened the meeting. Superintendent Culkeen gave an update of the budget building process and where we are right now. As this is early in the process, there is not a great deal to report. Teachers were instructed to have their budgets in by Friday, November 8 and most have completed this task. The business office and superintendent are working hard to establish a new process for the budget building. A better process of line by line justification of requested needs as opposed to the usual addition of a percentage, place holding of funds and expenditures of funds just because they are available is in the works for this year as we try to stay as close as possible to a zero based budget. Teachers will need to trust that the funds will be available if an emergency need occurs. Supplies are about the only area that we can adjust as many other expenses are set in stone due to contractual and out of our control increases-health insurance, utilities, MAU project expenses. The business office will be looking at software licensing renewals to see what our real needs are in this area. We plan to run leaner, check inventory closer and target special purchases for need. Tech education usually runs near a 75 to 25 split percentage wise with the 75% being personnel. It has been noted that equipment grants and funds are very hard to access at this time. State funding has dried up in many areas and is quite restrictive.
