

Southwest Vermont Regional Technical School District.	Residency Requirements for Student Enrollment	Policy # 3105C

It is the policy of the Southwest Vermont Regional Technical School District that any legal pupil who is a resident as defined in 16 V.S.A. §1075 and by State Rules 2371 and 2373 shall be eligible to attend any program of the Regional Technical School districts. The burden of proving residency or any other basis for entitlement to school enrollment shall be on the student and/or his or her parent or guardian. The Service region of the Southwest Vermont Regional Technical School District is identified in Rule 2374 of the Vermont State Board of Education as amended from time to time. Students residing outside the service area of the RTSD may enroll in programs of the RTSD so long as their own regional technical center does not provide that program, and they enroll on a space available basis.

Students in Vermont are entitled to enroll in and complete a technical education program of either part-time or full-time duration, whether they are enrolled in a high school or not. Students without a high school diploma shall have equal access to enroll in programs at the RTSD. Adults are entitled to enroll in a technical program on a space available basis as long as they meet the admission requirements for all students entering that program. Whether space is available is determined no later than two weeks prior to the first day of operation of the program.

Any interested person or taxpayer who is dissatisfied with the decision of the board as to the pupil's legal residence may appeal to the commissioner of education as provided in 16 VSA § 1075(b).
