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1 Policy

2 *The Curricula of the Southwest Vermont Regional Technical School District [CDC] shall be*  
3 *coordinated to allow students to meet or exceed standards established by the Vermont*  
4 *Frameworks as well as the standards established by the National Career Clusters Essential*  
5 *Knowledge and Skills Statements as adopted by the Vermont Department of Education Division*  
6 *of Career and Technical Education. Curricular plans shall be coordinated among the sending*  
7 *schools, the Program Advisory Committees, and the CDC and will be periodically reviewed.*

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9 *The Superintendent/Director shall be responsible for the development, coordination and*  
10 *evaluation of program and course curricula. The Superintendent shall ensure that the CDC's*  
11 *program and course curricula reflect the school district's mission as approved by the Regional*  
12 *Governing Board. The curricula shall also include opportunities for students to participate in*  
13 *Career Technical Student Organizations [CTSO's], and their regional and national*  
14 *competitions.*

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16 *The Superintendent/Director shall conduct systematic evaluations of all programs and courses*  
17 *within the curricula and report the results to the Regional Governing Board at least annually.*
