## Policy Committee Meeting Minutes, Monday June 17, 2024

Policy Committee meeting was opened at 3:59PM by Asher Edelson who noted we probably would not be seeing fellow committee member, Dane Whitman due to important votes at the State House. Edelson asked that today's committee work be concluded by 5PM or sooner. He then welcomed all and asked for any public comments. Hearing none, he moved to the first item on the agenda, election of a chair for the 2024/2025 year. Motions by Putney and Johnson to place Edelson as chair were unanimously received and Edelson humbly accepted. He noted that this committee could use a few more members and he would be looking into that.

Edelson requested that the Concussion Policy being considered for discussion be put at the head of the agenda. Some back and forth conversation as to whether this subject had been added with enough time for this discussion resulted in leaving the subject to the end of today's meeting. Policy warning and adoption procedures were discussed briefly for clarification. As this meeting is informational only, possible policy inclusions may be discussed before entering the correct adoption procedure for public awareness of any anticipated policy, new or updated.

 Policies #4080C, #4261C, 4276C, #4328C and #5080 were discussed with edits noted, some language, dates and Vermont State regulation changes anticipated and inclusion of administrative input relative to the current social climate. John Lamson, present Pre-Law Instructor and newly approved Assistant Director for SW Tech. will be doing the research needed to update, edit and inform the committee of changes needed before the next committee meeting. Some very good suggestions for modifications were made by committee members and by our newly approved Superintendent/Director, Meg Honsinger. Lamson added pertinent comments related to possible new state statues and social concerns. He will, over the summer, delve into the concerns noted and report his findings.

As the time was fast approaching 5PM, the committee decided to table any discussion concerning a Concussion Policy till the next meeting which will probably be in August. More information to come.
